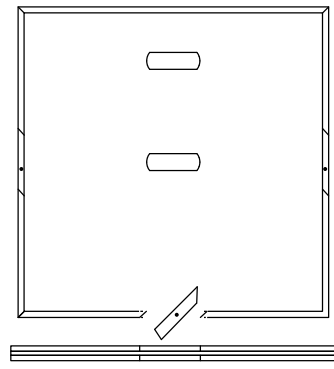


1. Snelgrove/Escape Board 460mm x 460mm

Snelgrove Board used for artificial swarming procedure (colony splitting) but can also serve as a Crown Board or Escape Board. Has 3 dual access ports. (Thorne's price: £40)

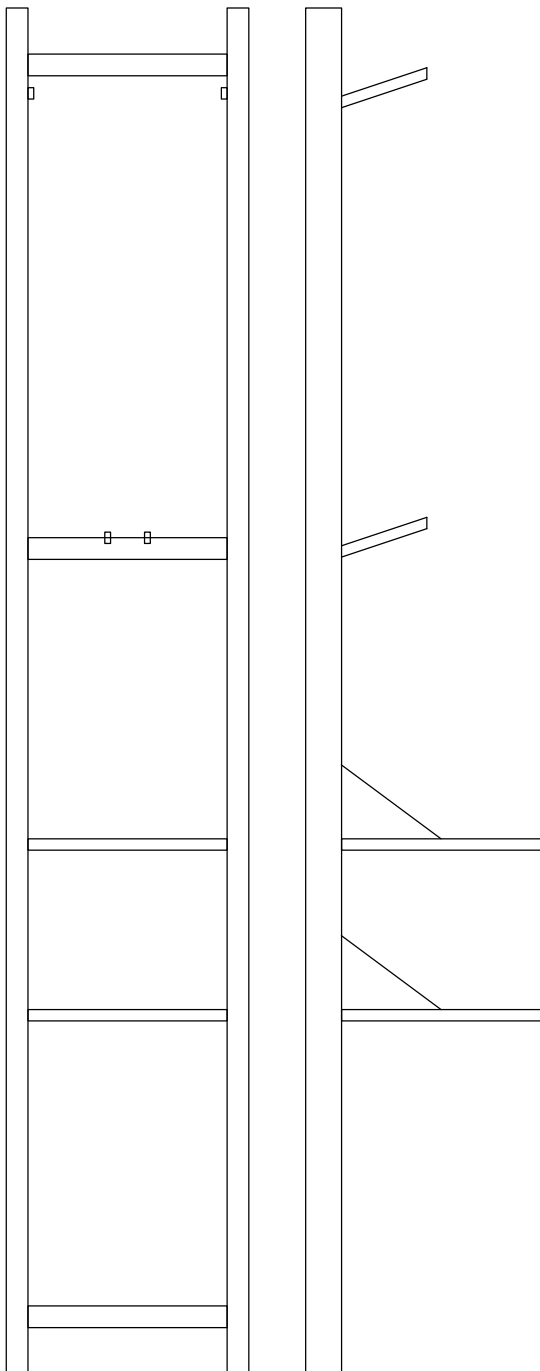


2. Bee-proof Carrier/storage box for National brood frames.

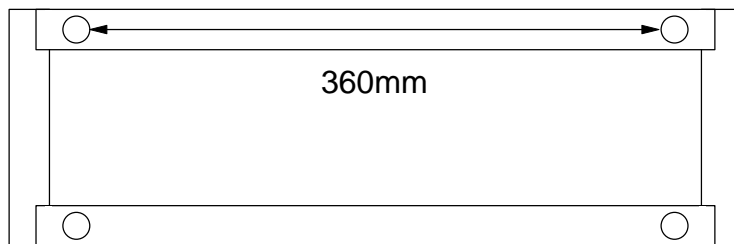
When inspecting hives it is not unusual to swap in new brood frames in the place of old, dirty ones. It is very useful to have a carrier box to hold the frames which is bee-proof. When pinning together new frames a storage box would also be helpful to hold frames until used. (Robert Dyas, plastic box £17)



3. A Useful wall rack (2.4m high) with hooks to hold Queen Excluders, Crown Boards and 2 shelves. New comers to beekeeping should be warned about the amount of storage space needed for equipment and tools.



4. A super frame rack, just what you need during extraction (Thorne's price £52)



5. Ekes used to get extra space in the hive for feeding, Varroa treatments and Winter insulation. Can also be used to convert 14x 8 into 14 x 12 brood boxes. (Thornes £30).
