Income down from 2012 – partly due to reduced membership. £6,000 income. Income in already for introduction course for 2014 (26 signed up). Excess petty cash has been deposited in the bank so only holding a small amount. Expenditure – apiary set up (cost less than expected). Stationary – paid for advertising and leaflets. The accounts auditor has been invited to the BCD xmas meal as a thank you. Budget meeting held for next year – education officer and apiary manger attended to discuss expenditure planned for 2014. £3,000 put aside for education.

Assets - new equipment has been purchased.

Membership stands at 152 members (135 full members).

Now able to put membership details on an online record that holds insurance and membership details. This will also enable the treasurer to print off insurance certificates if needed, for example those that may have hives in allotments.

Gift aid = 25% income from gift aid goes to ABKA. The vast majority of the members are now signed up. As we are a charity we have to be seen to be spending our income.

Q/ Adrian Wells asked whether there was a demographic showing in regards to lost membership.

A/ There are no details kept. Lost members were contacted via phone and email. It seems that the average is those that joined 3-4 years ago and have had several bad years of beekeeping. This is a national "drop-off". We as a branch are trying to improve support and mentoring to reduce this loss. Taking the basic exam - the number are at their highest for this branch this year.

Only 1/3 members are really "getting involved" in the activities of the branch. This year and next we are really investing in our education service and apiary.

Hans Wilson (member) -Has paid for the North Somerset show stand this year and is paying for a larger stand for 2014 also. This was a very successful show for the branch this year in sales, sign -ups for the introduction course and general public exposure. Thanks from the membership and committee.
